Dear Doctor/Office Manager:

Effective July 1, 2007, CMS (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services) has issued a specific Q code for billing Gamunex[®] (Immune Globulin Intravenous (human), 10% caprylate/chromatography purified). Similar new codes have also been issued for other liquid products.

The current common IGIV billing code J-1567 will be discontinued. In order to ensure prompt payment for Gamunex and to avoid any potential denials, please start using the following new code effective July 1, 2007 for Medicare claims.

IMPORTANT: For private payers, the rate of adoption of the new Q codes will vary significantly. Therefore, before billing these payers, you may want to check with them to determine if they have adopted the new Q code and then use it accordingly.

Gamunex – Q-4092 (INJECTION, IMMUNE GLOBULIN, (GAMUNEX), INTRAVENOUS, NON-LYOPHILIZED, (E.G. LIQUID), 500 MG)
